Introdução

Os Jogos Olímpicos são um evento multidesportivo global com modalidades de verão e de inverno, em que milhares de atletas participam de várias competições. Atualmente os Jogos são realizados a cada dois anos, em anos pares, com os Jogos Olímpicos de Verão e de Inverno se alternando, embora ocorram a cada quatro anos no âmbito dos respetivos jogos sazonais. Originalmente, os Jogos Olímpicos da Antiguidade foram realizados em Olímpia na Grécia, do século VIII a.C. ao século V d.C. No século XIX, o Barão Pierre de Coubertin fundou o Comitê Olímpico Internacional (COI) em 1894. O COI se tornou o órgão dirigente do Movimento Olímpico, cuja estrutura e as ações são definidas pela Carta Olímpica.

- Este relatório foi estabelecido para os Jogos Olímpicos de Tóquio 2020 pela necessidade de realizar um relatório para legado e preparação das próximas missões olímpicas da delegação da missão Cabo-verdiana.
- Este relatório servirá como uma ferramenta para avaliar os objetivos da missão olímpica que se pretende atingir, conforme definidos previamente na missão e quais os critérios atingidos na sua obtenção.
- Este relatório vai-se versar sobre a (1) equipa dos jogos, (2) período de estadia, (3) alojamento, alimentação e transportes, (4) equipamentos e competição, (5) Saúde e Anti doping, (6) Comunicação e Cerimónias (7) Financeira, (8) avaliação de objetivos de missão e (9) Recomendações e agradecimentos.



Momentos Chave - Planeamento

O Comité Olímpico Cabo-verdiano iniciou a preparação para os jogos olímpicos 2020 no início do ano de 2017. A lógica de preparação de uma missão Olímpica deverá ser sempre numa ótica Plurianual e que possibilite a recolha de informação útil para a tomada de decisão e além disso a possibilidade de preparar os vários elementos que integram a missão. O **relatório de missão é elaborado até 1T de 2022.**

Os momentos chave de execução da missão estão definidos pelo mapa do plano de estratégia de preparação realizado em 2017.

Viagens para Tokyo

- Todos os elementos da delegação, com exceção dos dignatários, chegaram efetivamente a Tokyo cumprindo todas as diretivas sanitárias e logísticas relativamente ao exigido pelo governo Japonês.
- A greve de 17 e 18 de Julho da ANA, impediram a chegada prevista dos elementos Filomena Fortes, Humberto Évora, Victor Hugo Fortes e Elton Gonçalves (chegando em altura posterior).
- O SG do COC chegou após das cerimónia de abertura (dia 25 de Julho) a seu pedido por imperativos de indisponibilidade profissional.
- O Dignatário acompanhante do Ministro do Desporto, transmitiu a sua não ida para os Jogos atempadamente, justificando motivos orçamentais e de natureza sanitária.
- O Dignatário Ministro do Desporto, após todas as démarches realizadas para a sua receção não aterrou no Aeroporto do Japão e mesmo solicitadas todas as informações necessárias para a não ida até ao momento não foi feita nenhuma comunicação formal a indicar que não estaria nos Jogos Olímpicos.
- O Chefe de missão, devidamente autorizado, alterou a sua viagem de regresso, partindo dia 6 de Agosto (mais cedo do que o planeado) por imperativos pessoais, ficando o Elton Gonçalves em substituição na chefia de missão.
- Não ficou efetiva a participação da ATO – Wania Monteiro e do Sr. Yano (voluntário Japonês) por indisponibilidade deste último.

Alojamento, alimentação e transportes

Alojamento

- O edifício da Team Cabo Verde em Tokyo2020 foi o numero 1 (um).
- Foram distribuídos 5 apartamentos com um total de 16 camas no 7º andas. Os números de apartamentos foram o 715, 716 (consultório médico), 717 (escritório), 718, 719.
- Os quartos (camas) dos atletas foram distribuídos e assinalados conforme solicitado pela ITA (anti doping).
- Os alojamentos eram confortáveis e suficientemente equipados em “free-itens” para o decurso dos Jogos.
- O material médico (marquesa, luz e armários) só foram distribuídos posteriormente após a chegada efetiva do CMO (médico) da equipa.
- O serviço de limpeza igualmente criou alguns constrangimentos por ter retirados alguns itens de higiene pessoal dos quartos considerando que os mesmos eram lixo.
- O alojamento do SG, foi inicialmente atribuído com menos de 8mts² de espaço (ao contrario dos 24 mts² contratualizados), pelo que foi alterado 2 dias depois.

Transporte

- NOC – PR e SG
 - Viatura dedicada com condutor funcionou com algumas deficiências, devido ao facto dos condutores apenas receberem instruções
- Chefe e Subchefe de missão
 - A viatura dedicada com condutor não funcionou. Foi necessário pedir uma alterado por 3 upgrade cards de T3 e solicitação de entrega das 2 viaturas dedicadas-
- Restante delegação
 - Viatura coletiva (TP,TA e TM), funcionaram com ocasionais atrasos (principalmente no início dos Jogos Olímpicos).

Alimentação

- A alimentação fornecida foi de qualidade, sendo que existia grande variedade de escolha.
- Os atletas conseguiram fazer eficazmente do *Grab n Go*, sendo que este se situava no R/C do edifício 1 (um), na qual era o edifício de Cabo Verde.
- O Casual Dinning foi igualmente uma boa alternativa de alimentação na vila.
- Nas *venues* a alimentação para o pessoal de delegação acreditado com “6” (seis) era também de qualidade suficiente e com pouca afluência onde Cabo Verde competiu.

Outras informações

- A temperatura no Japão durante a competição foi bastante elevada, contudo as medidas de hidratação tiveram efeito sobre a performance dos atletas. Houve um caso excepcional de desidratação da atleta Jayla Pina nos dias iniciais de treino que foi devidamente acautelado.
- Os 2 voluntários Japoneses foram apenas disponibilizados muito depois do início da missão (após dia 21 de Julho), contudo os mesmos foram muito pro-eficientes (sendo que um deles falava português).
- O SG do COC encontrou-se doente durante o decorrer da missão e foi acompanhado pelo Médico da equipa.
- Os Japoneses na sua maioria não falavam inglês, pelo que o uso da ferramenta de tradução “Google Translator” ou recurso aos nossos voluntários foi muito importante para o sucesso da missão.
- O serviço de lavandaria teve um normal funcionamento exceto durante os períodos de maior afluência na vila (22 a 25 de Julho).
- O Service Center e Fitness Center e Policlínica funcionário com grande eficiência, e cumpriram as necessidades da delegação de Cabo Verde.
- Foi bastante importante a visita dos “Embaixadores de Cabo Verde no Japão” (família Kataoka) para a quebra de rotina da equipa.

Equipamentos

Os equipamentos fornecidos pelo patrocinador “Quatrecent Quinze”, apenas 3 (três) dos 10 (dez) volumes disponibilizados foram levantados na alfandega.







Ainda se encontra hoje (30 de Agosto de 2021) os volumes para serem levantados, sendo que a data de chegada registrada pelo transitário foi de 12 de Julho de 2021.

Esta situação foi originada essencialmente por:

- Envio tardio dos equipamentos por parte do Fornecedor
- Altura de envio ser a altura de maior fluxo alfandegário em Cabo Verde (verão com remessas de emigrantes)

Por motivos na qual o COC é alheio, apenas parte dos equipamentos foi possível utilizar durante a missão de Tokyo2020 (afetando igualmente a delegação Paralímpica).

Saúde e Anti doping

Saúde e anti doping

De: Humberto Évora (CMO)

Nota prévia: A nossa atuação esteve sempre de acordo com os princípios do Olympic Movement Medical Code: Proteção da saúde dos atletas e minimizar o risco de lesões.

Previstas quatro áreas de intervenção médica:

1. Prevenção Covid-19
2. Controle anti Doping
3. Eventuais patologias intercorrentes
4. Lesões desportivas

Prevenção Covid-19

- Colaboração ativa com a organização do Jogos, no cumprimento das medidas preventivas emanadas da organização.
- Desempenho do papel de CLO (COVID-19 Liaison Officer) como elemento de ligação com a organização dos jogos, colaborando na monitorização das medidas preventivas, bem como no screening de testes a efetuar diariamente, a serem entregues no Olympic Village PCR Testing Center.

Saúde e anti doping

Controle Anti Doping:

- Realizou-se previamente uma sessão informativa sobre esta matéria em plataforma digital.
- Monitorização/aconselhamento de eventuais medicamentos ou suplementos a serem ingeridos pelos nossos atletas.
- Nenhum dos nossos atletas foi selecionado para controle anti doping.

Eventuais patologias intercorrentes:

- Treinador de atletismo com queixas de torcicolo. Resolvido com medicação.
- Elemento do staff diretivo com queixas sugestivas de lombalgia com sinais de compressão neurológica. Foi medicado e solicitou-se um exame diagnóstico de ressonância magnética na policlínica.
- Atleta de ginástica com coriza. Medicada.

Saúde e anti doping

Lesões desportivas:

Em geral, não houve nenhuma situação clínica considerada de gravidade.

Praticamente todos os atletas apresentaram queixas de mialgias de esforço, o que é frequente acontecer em alta competição, pelas cargas de treino a que são sujeitos. Tratados com o uso de pistola de massagens e massagem manual.

- **Ginástica rítmica:** nada a referir
- **Atletismo:** tendinopatia aquiliana em fase incipiente que o atleta já reportava à chegada. Sem repercussão com os treinos e competição.
- **Boxe:** colocação de kinesio-taping preventivo no ombro do atleta. Sem outras queixas.
- **Natação:** sem queixas
- **Judo:** sem queixas relevantes.

Não existiu nenhum caso de COVID19 durante a missão e todos as situações médicas foram encaminhadas e tratadas



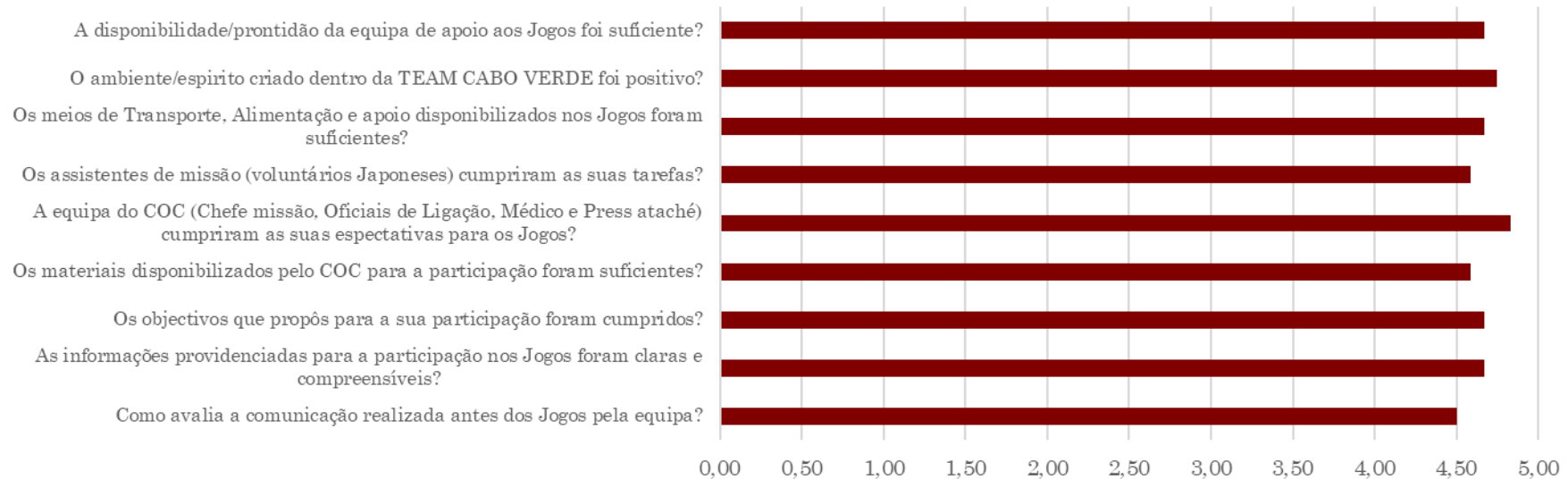
3. Garantir a interligação com outros Stakeholders dos Jogos para projeção do desenvolvimento do desporto em Cabo Verde.

Foi garantido a interligação com as federações internacionais de (1) Basebol, (2) Natação, (3) Judo e (4) Andebol por pedido das mesmas. Foram reforçados intercâmbios com (1) NOC Cômoros e (2) ACOLOP. Foi também reforçado contacto com a Solidariedade Olímpica.



Resultados de Inquérito

Recomendações

Na preparação de futuras missões Olímpicas é importante considerar os seguintes itens:

1

Compreender o que deve ser feito para efetivar o processo de comunicação com as entidades governamentais em Cabo Verde. Após o início de uma comunicação efetiva em Julho de 2017, esta comunicação terminou por não se concretizar no ano de decurso dos Jogos. Considerando que a missão olímpica é caracterizada por ser uma missão de utilidade pública e que ter conciliada apoios específicos nos termos da lei, deve o COC procurar manter uma relação harmoniosa (nos termos da Carta Olímpica) e entender porque motivo o processo de comunicação não ocorreu nos termos desejados. Notamos também, que nenhuma verba financeira foi inscrita no Orçamento de Estado de 2021 para os Jogos Olímpicos, mesmo considerando um planeamento de missão co-iniciado em Julho de 2017 com a (agora extinta) DGD - Direção Geral dos Desportos com comunicação constante por parte do COC.

O ciclo olímpico para Paris2024 é mais curto, sendo que o planeamento de missão deve iniciar no 4º Trimestre de 2021.

Paris2024 apresenta-se como uma excelente oportunidade para uma missão de delegação de Cabo Verde, na qual propõe-se uma intensificação de planeamento considerando os objetivos de missão com destaque a (1) cobertura mediática e (2) Patrocínios desportivos (3) Interligação como comunidade Olímpica – Partner House de Cabo Verde).

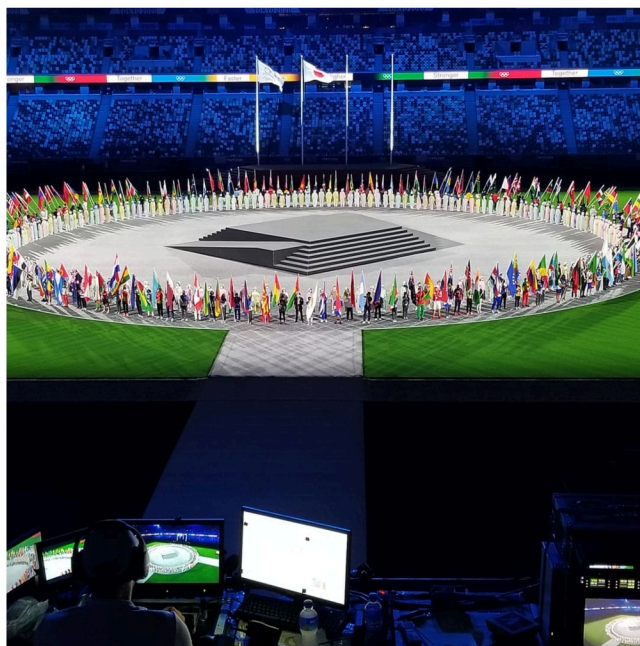

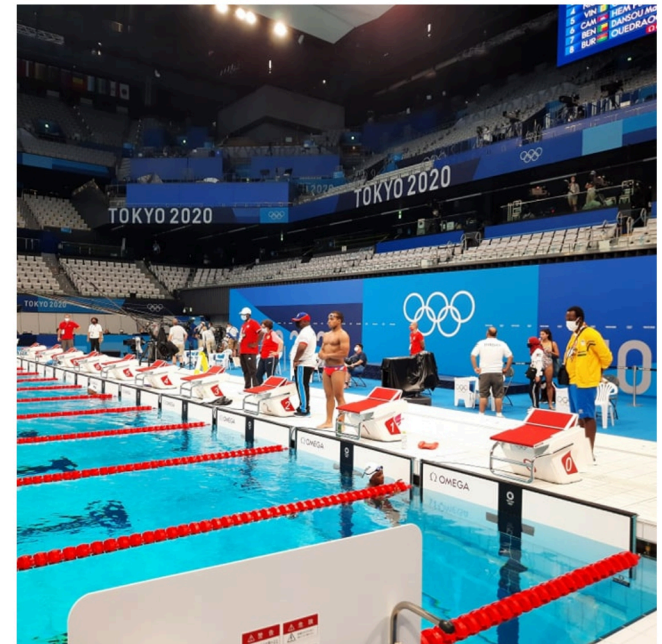
