When choosing the flight take into account the CO2 emissions

PROCUREMENT

- Evaluate all items that are bought and discard the non essencials
- Create a checklist to evaluate current suppliers
- Implement simple rules for selection of suppliers
- Search for new suppliers that meet the sustainable requirements

SUSTAINABILITY COMMUNICATION

- Place tips in the office with good practices to keep Sustainability on top of mind of the employees

UNIFORMS AND SPORTS EQUIPMENTS
